HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN CHILD ADVOCATES' PINWHEEL

- 1. Print this sheet double sided, cardstock works best but is not required.
- 2. Cute along the light black lines. Make sure you do not cut to far into the center or the center circle (the center cirle is just a guide).
- 3. Fold over each corner that has a pink dot, pull to the center and use a push pin to hold it down. Do not press down on the fold to make a crease in the paper.
- 4. Using the pushpin that is holding the corners together, push down into a dowel rod or pencil.
- 5. Enjoy, display and be the wind of change for an abused or neglected child!
